Dr. Frank earned BSEE and MSEE degrees from Stanford University, and a PhD in Computer Science from Carnegie Mellon University. Dr. Frank currently serves as a Member of the Computer Science and Telecommunications Board of the National Research Council, and is a Life Trustee of Carnegie Mellon University. He is Director of Fusion-io (FIO), and of privately-held eASIC. Dr. Frank is a named inventor on over 50 patents.
